- The Great Commandment and the Great Commission give Christ Followers a well-rounded job description. Read Matthew 22:37-40 and Matthew 28:19-20, then list the things we are called to be and to do.
- Read 2 Corinthians 5:17-21 brainstorm a list of the actions in this passage and then divide them into categories of who is responsible for each action.
- John 20:21 reads "So Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you; as the Father has sent Me, I also send you." Who was Jesus sent to and why? What does it mean to you to be sent as Jesus was sent? What does that look like?

- When you hear the job title "missionary", what comes to mind? Have you ever considered that you are a missionary? Why or why not?
- Who is in your spheres of influence? In what ways have you had the occasion to be Christ's Ambassador to them?

Do

Consider how this all plays out in our lives and apply it to everyday life.

- Learn the names of your neighbors and begin to pray for them.
- Ask God to give you opportunities that you can care for your neighbors. This can be as simple as picking up their mail when they are away, to bringing them a meal when they are sick or mowing their lawn because you have time in your schedule.
- Look for ways you can share the truths of scripture and ultimately the gospel with your neighbors.
