#### Start Talking: Find a conversation starter for your group or use one of these.

When have you experienced an unexpected opportunity that changed your perspective?

Please read **Hebrews 4:12-16** aloud.

- How does this passage describe the power of God's Word? Does that give you confidence to approach God in our weakness?

Please read **Genesis 22:9-14** aloud.

- Using Abraham's example, what areas of your life is God asking you to trust Him even when the outcome is unclear?

#### **Ephesians 1:7 GW**

"Through the blood of His Son, we are set free from our sins. God forgives our failures because of His overflowing kindness."

- How does knowing that we are redeemed by His blood shape the way you respond to guilt or failure in your daily life?

#### **John 14:6 AMP**

"Jesus said to him, 'I am the [only] Way [to God] and the [real] Truth and the [real] Life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.'"

- Reviewing the above passage: What does it mean for your everyday choices and relationships to fully trust in Him as truth, especially when other paths or voices compete for your attention?

## TALK IT OVER

### Start Praying: Be bold and pray with power.

Father, we are in absolute awe of Your incredible grace, the mystery that was prophesied long ago and now unfolds in Jesus, the Lamb who was slain. Thank You that as we receive Him, accept His blood, and go through the door of faith, we are welcomed into Your presence. Lord, help us to live fully in that confidence, trusting Your Word, and walking boldly in the grace You've provided. In Jesus' name, Amen.

**Leader:** Make time to pray for and with each other. Break into groups of three, take time for healing prayer, or pray with individuals requesting prayer. This is important!

### Start Doing:

Take a quiet moment each day to reflect on where you see Jesus knocking at your door-inviting you into a deeper trust, a step of obedience, a fresh perspective, or perhaps opening that first door to a new relationship with Him.

#### **Revelation 3:19-20 NIV**

"Those whom I love, I rebuke and discipline. So be earnest and repent. Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me."
