Start Talking: Find a conversation starter for your group or use one of these.

If you had unlimited resources, what would you choose to “acquire” and why?

Please read **Matthew 6:4-15** aloud.

- In what area of your life do you most need to see God’s provision right now?
- As you read this passage, what does provision look like in your life - both everyday needs and the deeper longings?

Please read **Psalms 23** aloud.

- What specific ways does David say God provides for him?
- How does that shape your own understanding of God’s provision in your life?

Please read **Nehemiah 2:17-18** aloud.

- As you see Nehemiah’s courage to rebuild, what is a prompting or a desire inside you that God might be calling you to act on?

Read **Jeremiah 29:11-13** aloud.

- God promises a future and hope - how does this help you see His heart for you? - even in unexpected circumstances?
- How does it impact you to know that God’s purpose for your life was established even before you knew it?

TALK IT OVER

Start Praying: Be bold and pray with power.

Lord, thank You for being our constant provider, the One who sees our needs even before we ask. We are grateful that you provided such a cloud of witnesses that wrote Your Word.
