Start Talking: Find a conversation starter for your group or use one of these.

Please share a time when something broken was restored or when a new beginning came after a hard season.

Please read **Acts 10:10-16 and then Acts 10:34-36** aloud.

- How is God inviting me to see others beyond my own biases or comfort zones?
- In what areas of my life am I being called to step out in faith by trusting God's bigger plan?

Psalm 147:3 AMP

"He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds [healing their pain and comforting their sorrow]."

- How can I be a source of comfort and healing to others today?
- In what ways have I experienced God's healing?

Please read **Romans 12:17-19 and verse 21** aloud.

- When I'm tempted to respond with revenge or negativity, how can I choose a path of goodness and peace?
- How can I trust God to bring justice, even when I feel the urge to defend myself?

Please read **2 Timothy 1:7 and then Matthew 5:9** aloud.

- When I feel fear or timidity, how is God calling me to step forward in courage and peace (even in difficult situations)?

TALK IT OVER

Start Praying: Be bold and pray with power.

Father, our hearts are full of hope, knowing that in You there is resurrection power. We thank You that Your Holy Spirit heals us. You bind up our wounds and restore our families. Lord, help us to take the first step toward healing, that we would not respond to negativity with more negativity, but with Your love. Teach us to affirm healthy boundaries, guarding our hearts as You do, and give us courage to extend peace even when it feels hard. May we walk in the power of Your Spirit, as peacemakers and as witnesses to Your grace. In Jesus' precious name, amen.

Leader: Make time to pray for and with each other. Break into groups of three, take time for healing prayer, or pray with individuals requesting prayer. This is important!

Start Doing:

This week, intentionally seek one moment of healing in your own life - take a step toward peace, affirm a boundary, or reach out with kindness. As you do, let the Holy Spirit guide you, knowing that God is at work in you. As the Holy Spirit brought reconciliation to Peter and Cornelius, may we also be agents of healing, peace, and bold love in our families and beyond.
