Start Talking: Find a conversation starter for your group or use one of these.

What's a personal milestone or challenge you've recently overcome, and what helped you get through it?

Please read **Hebrews 12:1-2 and then Isaiah 26:3** aloud.

- What specific distractions or fears do you need to lay aside, so you can rest in the perfect peace that God promises?
- How do you define "perfect peace" and is it attainable?

Please read **Philippians 3:8-11 and Proverbs 3:5-6** aloud.

- How does trusting God with all your heart invite you into a deeper, more eternal perspective?
- What does eternal perspective mean?

Please read **Micah 6:8 and 2 Timothy 4:6-8** aloud.

- How does Micah's call to humble, just, and merciful living shape the kind of legacy you want to leave like Paul describes in his final days?
- What does it look like to keep the faith daily, in small acts of justice and mercy, so that we can say we have fought the good fight and kept the faith?

TALK IT OVER

Start Praying: Be bold and pray with power.

Lord, our God, please help us apply the message from this week. You have laid the truth before us today, thank you. Help us to count all things as loss compared to the surpassing worth of knowing Christ. Teach us to trust You with all our hearts, not leaning on our own understanding, and give us the strength to walk humbly, act justly, and love mercy in every step. As we go from here, Lord, help us focus on a strong finish, with our eyes fixed on You, and our faith anchored in Your promises. In Jesus' precious name we pray, amen.

Leader: Make time to pray for and with each other. Break into groups of three, take time for healing prayer, or pray with individuals requesting prayer. This is important!

Start Doing:

Pause and reflect on how God is calling me to turn toward Him today. How does the certainty of God's coming justice give me both urgency and hope as I live out my faith this week?
