Money Matters

- \$900 ground costs include housing, food, ground transportation in Honduras, translation services, and insurance.
- Delta Airfare - \$800 estimate (give or take \$200).
- If you choose the Ground Cost + Airfare Option, the church will arrange for your flight and you will be able to apply church fundraising toward your total cost (ground+airfare).
- If you wish to use points/miles to pay for all or part of your airfare, please choose the Ground Cost Only option. You will not be able to apply church fundraising toward your airfare cost.
- Other costs may include luggage fees, airport food, souvenir/snacks, and offerings.
- Fundraising opportunities will be offered.
- Students receive a \$200 discount.

Passport

Everyone participating on this trip will need a US passport. If you don't already have one, you need to apply as soon as possible.

If your passport is due to expire within six months after the trip dates, please reapply as soon as possible.

Frequently Asked Questions

Accommodations? Guest house in the middle of Ayapa village. Dorm room (men and women separate) with bunk beds, AC, and bathrooms. Clean and safe.

Food? Most meals prepared and enjoyed at the guest house. Honduran cuisine with some American favorites. Food prepared to our standards of sanitation. All food and water offered to us will be safe. We may eat in a restaurant a couple of times during the week.

Safety? Traveling anywhere has its risks and the dangers you might face in Honduras are no greater than in most countries, including the USA. We take steps to mitigate any issues and our Honduran friends take our safety very seriously. Our biggest risk will be food illness.

Weather? Hot and humid, much like our summer.

Clothing Needed? You will receive a detailed packing list before we travel. Ladies will need dresses/skirts for church and outreach. Men will need casual pants/polos for church and outreach.

Vaccines? Up to date tetanus booster.

Do I need to speak Spanish? No...we will have translators. Knowing a few Spanish phrases can be helpful. The Google Translate app is a very useful tool.

Anything fun planned? Hopefully, you will enjoy doing the mission work and spending time with our team/Honduran friends. If time allows, we may visit a grocery store in Yoro for snacks. We may also visit nearby attractions.
