Sermon in a sentence: Christ himself calls all people, even His enemies, in all circumstances at all times to worship the Covenant-keeping LORD.

I. A universal call to all humanity to exclusively worship the LORD: vv. 1-6 (sing, sing, sing)

II. A universal call to join the family of the LORD in worship: vv. 7-10 (ascribe, ascribe, ascribe)

III. A universal call to all of creation to worship the LORD: vv. 11-13 (let, let, let)
