



Centreville Baptist Church Member Covenant

Having been led by the grace of God through the life-giving power of the Holy Spirit to repent of my sin and, in faith, turn to Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior and having given public testimony of this faith through baptism, I now joyfully and solemnly enter into this covenant with the members of Centreville Baptist Church, Inc. (hereinafter CHURCH):

I commit, through the power of the Holy Spirit, to affirm and follow the Basic Beliefs and Covenant in the Church Constitution, to walk together in love, to remember one another in prayer, to help one another in times of need, to exercise gentleness and humility in our dealings with one another as we speak the truth in love, to be faithful in our responsibilities and commitments, to be just and honest in our dealings, and to honor ourselves and others for Christ's sake through sexual purity, personal integrity, and abstaining from things or practices which bring harm to our faith or the faith of another.

I commit to faithful participation in times of worship, prayer, study, and fellowship with other believers, to the building up of the church by using our spiritual gifts in ministry, to contributing cheerfully and regularly to the ministry and expenses of the church, the relief of the poor, and the spread of the gospel to the world.

I commit to practicing personal and family worship, training our children in the discipline and instruction of the Lord, and seeking the salvation of our family, friends, neighbors, co-workers, acquaintances, and all peoples of the world.

I agree to be bound by the Articles, Constitution, and Bylaws, including those policies dealing with church discipline, conflict resolution and members' rights and responsibilities, and holy covenant, as well as accompanying policies and procedures.

I commit to submit to the teaching and leadership of the Church, to the governing of the church according to its Bylaws, and to the settlement of disputes by and/or among the members of the church without appeal to any outside civil court as addressed in I Corinthians 6:1-8. The Word of God is our final authority in imposing the church's discipline. We lovingly assume our responsibility to participate in the discipline of other members, as taught in Scripture according to Matthew 18:15-20.
