Camp Packing List 2026

What to Bring?

- Clothing for the week, including a sweatshirt or jacket for cooler evenings
- Extra T-shirts - It will be hot and humid during the day, so a clean shirt for the evening is recommended (short sleeves; no spaghetti straps)
- Casual shorts, jeans, or capris (appropriate shorts need to be at your fingertips when your arms are down by your sides)
- Sneakers/tennis shoes with closed toes and closed heels are required for the ropes course and most recreational activities
- Swim trunks, modest bathing suits, and flip-flops for the pool/lake (Please review Black Rock's swimwear guidelines below)
- Beach towel
- Rain jacket
- Toiletries - toothbrush, deodorant, shampoo/body wash, etc.
- Sunscreen
- Bug spray
- Bible, journal, and pen
- Reusable water bottle
- Hat and sunglasses (optional)
- Shower shoes (optional)
- Flashlight (optional)
- Gift shop money (optional)

Lodging Accommodations: Students will be staying in hotel-style rooms at [Black Rock's Maranatha Retreat Center](#). Rooms accommodate 3-4 students and feature one queen bed, 2-3 twin beds, and a private bathroom. (See photos below.)

Additional Room Information:

- Air-conditioned rooms with individual thermostats
- Linens and towels are provided, including sheets, blankets, pillows, pillowcases, bath towels, hand towels, and washcloths!
- Complimentary soap is provided in each room. Additional toiletries, including shampoo, conditioner, shower caps, toothbrushes, toothpaste, and hair dryers, are available at the front desk upon request



Please Note: Weapons, tobacco products, alcohol, vapes, and any illegal substances are strictly prohibited on the campgrounds.

Guidelines for Swimwear: Black Rock requires that women wear modest bathing suits (no bare midribs or bikinis) and that men wear modest swim trunks (no Speedo-style swimwear).
