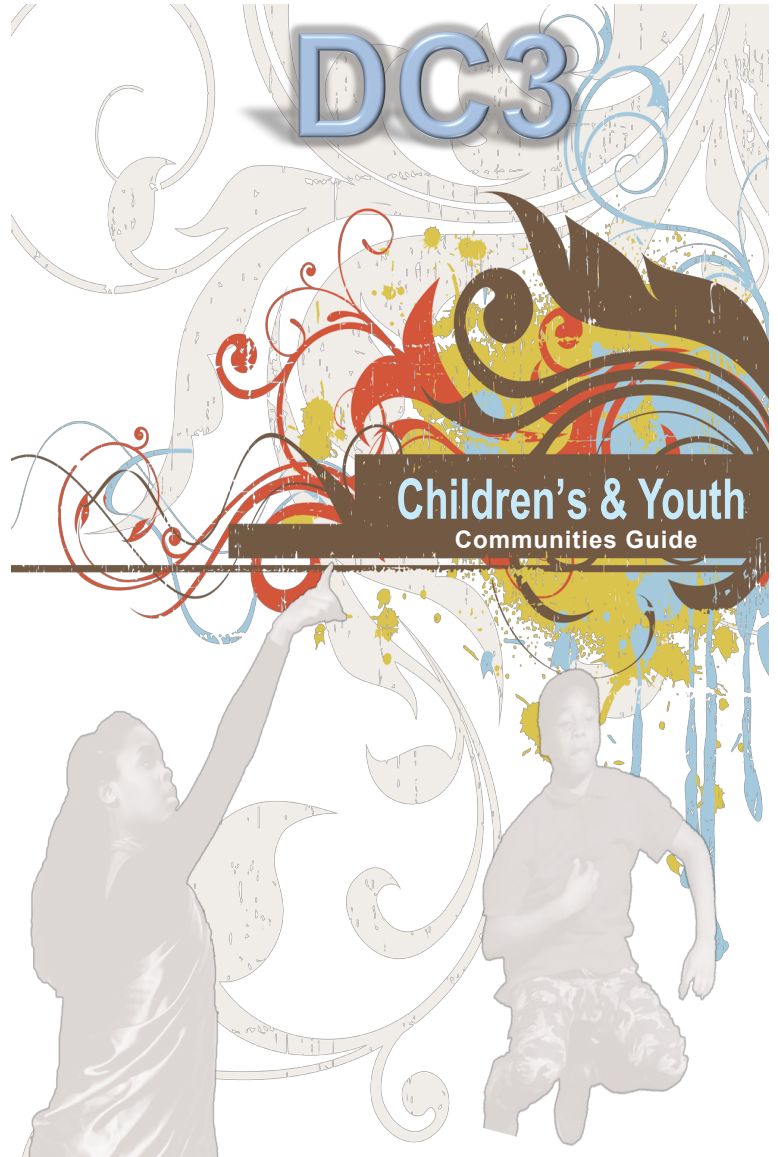

Behavior Expectations & Discipline Protocol

- Dress appropriate for church

Discipline:

Warning: Children will be warned when exhibiting inappropriate behavior

Parent Call or Meeting: If child is disrespectful and not behaving appropriately, the Children and Youth coordinator will be notified, and a plan will be discussed with the parent to rectify the problem.

Suspension: Child will be asked to leave class for a set amount of time until behavior changes. This will only occur at the approval of the senior pastor.

Parent Role & Responsibilities

- All children must be checked-in and checked-out by an adult at the Children's Desk. No adult is allowed beyond the registration desk.
- For the safety of all students, please do not sign your child in if he/she is sick
- Please contact the community 2 weeks before registering your child if he/she has special needs or accommodations
- Bring child to church regularly
- Bring child to classes consistently
- Make sure child is prepared for class and has his/her bible (No cell phones, tablets, or toys)
- Communicate pertinent information to team and teachers that will assist them in working with your child more effectively
- Become a Parent on Duty and volunteer in the children and youth communities
- Complete permission slip for all fellowship outings



Youth Role & Responsibilities

- Check in
- Remain in the designated area
- Bring bible and paper /pencil to take notes
