Someone read **Psalm 122:1**. Spend some time and share some key words that spoke out to you while reading. What is it about those words that spoke to you?

1. What is the difference between doing something because you have to and doing something because you genuinely want to? How does that apply to worship?
2. What is the difference between attending church out of habit and gathering with God's people out of genuine desire?
3. **Read Psalm 122:1**. Why do you think David was glad about gathering for worship? What do you think he understood that many believers today may have forgotten?
4. Have you ever gone into a worship service discouraged, distracted, or exhausted and left feeling refreshed? What do you think happened in that moment?
5. What are some things that can slowly steal our joy in worship without us even realizing it?
6. **Read Hebrews 10:24-25**. According to this passage, what are some things that happen when believers gather together that cannot happen in the same way when we remain isolated?
7. Why do you think Satan works so hard to isolate Christians from meaningful relationships with other believers?
8. Think about a person whose passion for Christ has encouraged your faith. What was it about their life that influenced you?
9. **Read John 4:23**. Jesus says the Father is seeking worshipers. What does that tell us about what God values most when His people gather?

10. What are some subtle ways people can begin loving church activities while neglecting a genuine love for God Himself?
11. If someone looked at your schedule, priorities, spending, and conversations over the last month, what would they conclude you treasure most?
12. **Read Psalm 63:1.** David wrote these words while in the wilderness. What does his longing for God teach us about worship during difficult seasons of life?
13. Why do you think it is often easier to be passionate about sports, hobbies, vacations, or entertainment than it is to be passionate about worship?
14. **Read 2 Corinthians 3:18.** How does regularly beholding God's glory change a person over time? Where have you seen that transformation in your own life?
15. Many people say, "That's just not my personality" when it comes to expressing worship. How do we distinguish between personality preferences and wholehearted surrender to God?
16. What have you done this week to be a blessing to someone? Share.
