1. What are some temporary things people often pursue to satisfy a longing that only God can truly fill?
2. **Read Ecclesiastes 3:11**. How does believing that God has placed eternity in every human heart change the way we view the people we encounter each day?
3. Have you ever been surprised to learn that someone who seemed to have it all together was actually carrying a heavy burden? What did that teach you about the way we view people?
4. What are some everyday situations where we tend to see interruptions instead of opportunities?
5. **Read Acts 4:13**. What kind of evidence convinces people that someone has genuinely been with Jesus, even before they say a word?
6. Why do you think God so often chooses ordinary people instead of the most talented or impressive people to accomplish His work?
7. When have you felt unqualified to do something God was calling you to do, and what did that experience reveal about your faith?
8. **Read Acts 9:17**. What can we learn from Ananias about obeying God even when we don't know how the story will end?
9. Which is harder for you: seeing people through eternal eyes, making yourself available, or speaking about Christ? Why?
10. How can fear quietly keep us from living out our faith even when our intentions are good?

11. **Read Esther 4:13-16.** What helps a person choose obedience when the cost feels high?
12. What would change in your daily routine if you intentionally believed that God had strategically placed you where you are right now?
13. What is the difference between trying to win an argument and trying to point someone toward Christ?
14. **Read 2 Corinthians 5:20.** What does it practically look like to live as Christ's ambassador in your workplace, school, neighborhood, or home?
15. Looking back years from now, what kind of spiritual legacy would make you feel that your life truly mattered?
16. What have you done this week to be a blessing to someone? Share.
