Someone read **1 Corinthians 1:1-9**. Spend some time and share some key words that spoke out to you while reading. What is it about those words that spoke to you?

1. What do you believe our church is becoming known for, and what does that reveal about what matters most to us?
2. After reading 1 Corinthians 1:1–9, which truth in Paul’s opening would most change the way someone sees themselves or the church, and why?
3. Why does lasting change begin with understanding our identity rather than simply correcting our behavior?
4. Where do Christians most often confuse attending a church with genuinely being built together as a church family?
5. Read **1 Corinthians 1:2**. In what area of life does belonging to Christ need to have a greater influence on the way we live?
6. What tends to move Jesus out of the center of a church, even when that church still appears successful?
7. Why do believers sometimes continue trying to earn God’s acceptance after they have already received it through Christ?
8. Read **Ephesians 2:8–9**. How should receiving salvation as a gift shape the way we respond to both our successes and our failures?
9. How would the way we correct others change if we consistently viewed them through the lens of God’s grace?
10. In what ways can comparing ourselves with other people or churches keep us from faithfully using what God has already given us?
11. Read **Matthew 25:14–30**. What has God placed in your hands that you may be overlooking while wishing He had given you something more?

12. How can a spiritual gift become harmful when someone uses it for recognition rather than for the glory of Christ?
13. When life becomes overwhelming, why is our first instinct often to depend on ourselves instead of trusting God to sustain us?
14. Read **Philippians 1:6**. What unfinished work of God is hardest for you to trust right now, and what makes the waiting difficult?
15. If our church looked more like Jesus one year from now, what would be noticeably different about the way we treat one another?
16. How have you been a blessing to someone this week? Share.
