Let's Dig Deeper

Someone read **1 Corinthians 1:10-17**. Spend some time and share some key words that spoke out to you while reading. What is it about those words that spoke to you?

1. What kinds of preferences are Christians most likely to mistake for biblical convictions? For example, someone may treat a preferred style of worship as the only biblical way to worship.
2. Read **1 Corinthians 1:10**. What would being “united in the same mind and the same judgment” look like in a church filled with different personalities and opinions?
3. Why is it sometimes easier to distance ourselves from someone than to have the difficult conversation needed for healing?
4. How can we tell when a disagreement has begun turning into division?
5. Read **1 Corinthians 1:11–12**. What do the different groups in Corinth reveal about the human desire to belong, compare, and compete?
6. What is the difference between seeking help about a conflict and spreading gossip about it?
7. How can a good leader, ministry, or church tradition begin taking a place in our hearts that belongs only to Jesus?
8. Read **Mark 9:33–34**. What might the disciples’ silence reveal about what was happening in their hearts?
9. What usually makes being right feel more important than being loving?
10. How can we disagree strongly with another believer without treating that person like an enemy?

11. Read **1 Corinthians 1:13**. What does the question “Is Christ divided?” reveal about the seriousness of division among believers?
12. What does it look like to pursue reconciliation while still maintaining wisdom and healthy boundaries?
13. How does remembering that the Church belongs to Jesus change the way we respond when we do not get our way?
14. Read **1 Corinthians 1:17**. In what ways can human pride draw attention away from the power of the Cross?
15. What relationship or disagreement in your life might change if you approached it from the foot of the Cross?
16. How have you been a blessing to someone this week? Share.
