## Get To Know You Question:

What is one completely random thing you are weirdly committed to that makes no sense to most people?

## Let's Dig Deeper

Someone read **Acts 21:1-6**. Spend some time and share some key words that spoke out to you while reading. What is it about those words that spoke to you?

1. What tends to pull you off track most easily: fear, comfort, convenience, or the opinions of others? Why do you think that has such a strong grip on you?
2. When you know God is calling you to something difficult, what usually becomes the biggest internal struggle you face before taking action?
3. Read **Acts 21:12-14**. Why do you think the people urging Paul not to go were sincere and loving, yet still wrong? How can well-meaning people unintentionally pull us away from obedience?
4. What are some subtle ways distraction or diversion shows up in your daily life that could slowly pull you away from what God is calling you to do?
5. Which type of commitment do you relate to most right now: incomplete, insincere, or intermittent? What makes you say that?
6. Where in your life might there be more appearance than substance when it comes to your walk with Christ?
7. Read **Acts 20:22-24**. What stands out to you about Paul's mindset toward his life and calling? How different is that from the way most people approach life?
8. What is something God may be calling you to do that feels like it would cost too much right now? What makes that cost feel so significant?
9. Read **Luke 9:23**. What does it practically look like to "deny yourself" in your current season of life?

10. Think about a time you were confident about what God wanted you to do but didn't follow through. What specifically pulled you away in that moment?
11. How can you honor and love the people in your life while still remaining fully obedient to what God is calling you to do?
12. Read **Matthew 6:27, 34**. Why do you think worry is so persistent in our lives even when we know it doesn't actually help anything?
13. How does forgetting your worth in God's eyes affect your willingness to step out in obedience or take spiritual risks?
14. What are some practical ways to strengthen a conviction so that it doesn't shift based on circumstances or emotions?
15. It is time for accountability. Share with your LifeGroup one specific conviction that God has placed on your heart. Share one clear and specific step towards obedience this week.
16. What did you do last week to be a blessing to someone? Share with the group. And what are you planning for this week?
