Let's Dig Deeper

Someone read **1 Peter 2:5** and **1 Peter 2:9**. Spend some time and share some key words that spoke out to you while reading. What is it about those words that spoke to you?

1. Read **1 Peter 2:9**. What part of Peter's description of believers stands out to you the most right now, and why?
2. What are some ways people slowly lose their awe and reverence for God without even realizing it?
3. Read **1 Peter 2:5**. What does it mean that we are “being built up” together instead of growing alone?
4. What are some things people commonly build their lives on that eventually fail under pressure?
5. Why do you think God chose people, not buildings or programs, to carry His message to the world?
6. Read **Psalm 96:2-3**. Why does genuine joy naturally lead people to speak about what they love?
7. What does our silence about Jesus sometimes reveal about our hearts?
8. In what ways can everyday faithfulness become a powerful testimony to others without standing on a stage or preaching a sermon?
9. Read **Matthew 5:14-16**. What are some practical ways believers can “shine” in ordinary daily life?
10. Why do you think so many people today are searching for hope, even when outwardly they appear successful or happy?

11. Read **Ephesians 5:8**. How is “you were darkness” different from simply saying “you were in darkness”?
12. What are some “false lights” people chase that promise fulfillment but eventually leave them empty?
13. When you think back to your life before Christ, what areas of darkness or confusion stand out the most to you now?
14. How does remembering what God rescued us from help keep our gratitude and passion for Christ alive?
15. What would it look like for Living Stones Church to truly become “a people carrying His message” in this next season of ministry?
16. What did you do last week to be a blessing to someone? Share with the group. And what are you planning for this week?
