1. Someone read **1 Peter 2:4-5**. What do you think Peter means when he says we are "living stones" being built together into a spiritual house?
2. Why do you think so many Christians today struggle to stay deeply connected to other believers instead of trying to live the Christian life alone?
3. How does viewing Christianity as union with Christ rather than simply performing for Christ change the way you relate to God?
4. What are some ways God has "chiseled" or shaped your life through difficult seasons?
5. Someone read **Acts 17:24**. How should it affect us knowing that God's presence now dwells among His people and not in a physical temple?
6. Why is it easier to focus on buildings, programs, and appearances than on spiritual growth and unity within the church?
7. Someone read **Hebrews 10:19-22**. What keeps believers from fully approaching God with confidence even though Christ has already opened the way?
8. What does it practically look like to live as a "holy priesthood" during an ordinary week?
9. What convictions are hardest to hold onto when life becomes difficult or costly?
10. Someone read **1 Peter 2:9**. Which description stands out to you the most: chosen race, royal priesthood, holy nation, or God's possession? Why?

11. Why do you think people are so desperate to find identity in success, politics, relationships, or approval?
12. Someone read **Ephesians 1:4–5**. How does the idea of being adopted by God reshape the way a Christian should view themselves?
13. Why is genuine Christian community so difficult to build today?
14. Someone read **Ephesians 2:4–5**. How does remembering God’s mercy produce humility and gratitude in a believer’s life?
15. “Who are we? What are we becoming? What are we building together?” Which of those questions do you think Christians and churches wrestle with the most today?
16. What did you do last week to be a blessing to someone? Share with the group. And what are you planning for this week?
