Warm Up: Favorite 'odd' thing from your family?

1. When you think about family, why did God establish it?
2. From Genesis 25 we see Joseph's lineage has a hell-bent struggle with lying, manipulation and power moves. This messy history sets a destructive pattern for a family to function. What family practices have you observed that weren't the best?
3. By the time Joseph comes along (Gen. 37:2-4) he has 10 older brothers and is tattle-telling on their activities and has become the father's favorite. How can one keep envy and jealousy in check? In a family, how can you keep them checked?
4. Envy & Jealousy are fueled even more by Joseph's dreams (Gen. 37:5-8). God provided these to anchor Joseph for his future. How could he have shared them differently?
5. Joe's family is messy! They scheme to kill him, decide to sell him, lie about the circumstances of his disappearance and work to live as if he never existed. But 22 yrs later the brothers stood before their unrecognized brother, Joe asking for help. What allowed Joseph to be so gracious and help his brothers (Gen 50:15, 20-21)?
6. When you trust God and turn over your history, he can take messes and make masterpieces! How has he worked out some of your messes for good?
