Creation's Restoration!

Warm Up: If you were to restore something, what would it be? Why?

A1. When God created, he declared it "Good" (sun, moon, plants, animals, etc.) and "Very Good" – humanity. Although all rebelled, God never changed his declaration over creation. What comes to your mind with the heading, 'Creation's Restoration'?

2. Read 2 Peter 3:10-13. What catches your attention with this intense language? If you have a Bible App on our phone, read this passage in the English Standard Version. I envision something like a laser 'dissolving' the old paint, rust, & grime to expose the original pre-painted piece. Can you picture less annihilation and more a preparation for the 'new restored' heaven & earth? Share your reflections.

3. Read Revelation 21:1-2. These two verses provide a brief description about what is coming, what picture do they provide?

4. Read Revelation 21:3-4. These two verses broaden the reality of the 'New Earth'. What is described? What is your reaction to what is described?

5. How does verses 3 & 4 align with what you imagined life to be in the Garden of Eden in Genesis?

6. God is of the mission of restoration. For your future, "New Heaven & Earth" and for you present, a restoration of a heart that longs for him. How is Jesus working his restoration process in your life now? What does that look like?
