My clubber did not finish their book last year, can they do so this year?

If your child is in Sparks, they continue in the book they are in until they complete it and then get the next book in the series. Other clubber may finish up any incomplete book **along with** the current book that their club is doing. Please let the leader know what your clubbers intentions are at the beginning of the year.

We missed a week, can more than one memory verse be recited per week?

Yes, your clubber may make up any memory versed that they have missed. They are encouraged to stay with the group in their book.

Is there anything for parents to do while AWANA is happening?

YES! Parents are welcome to join the Prayer Meeting that happens in the sanctuary at the same time as AWANA.

What are the points that clubbers earn?

Clubbers earn points for every section of their book that they complete. This includes their weekly Memory Verse. They also earn points every week for wearing their uniform, bringing their handbook, bringing their bible, going to church, wearing sneakers and for participating in whatever special night it may be. Clubbers also get bonus points for bringing a friend to AWANA. We keep a spreadsheet of the points, and the kids get to spend them at Store Night.
