In addition to their traditional programs of Street Outreach, Literacy and Skills Training, Spiritual Development and After-Graduation Care, in 2025 **MADE IN THE STREETS expanded their work to focus on family-based care for street-connected youth and changed their name to REMADE.**

We believe, and research confirms that children thrive best in family settings. For this reason, we will do all we can to help families build their capacities and provide safe and loving homes for their children. With that in mind, REMADE is adding to our programs this year in the following ways:

1. Prioritizing family reunification, helping children return home when possible, and offering temporary care when needed.
2. Prevention of youth homelessness— supporting families and communities before children turn to the streets.
3. Partnering with other organizations to make sure this transition goes smoothly.

The original programs aren't going anywhere. We know that there will still be many kids who cannot be reunited safely with their families. So, our Outreach, Education, and Aftercare Programs will remain the same.
