- * put together fruit baskets/ snacks for shut-ins, etc.

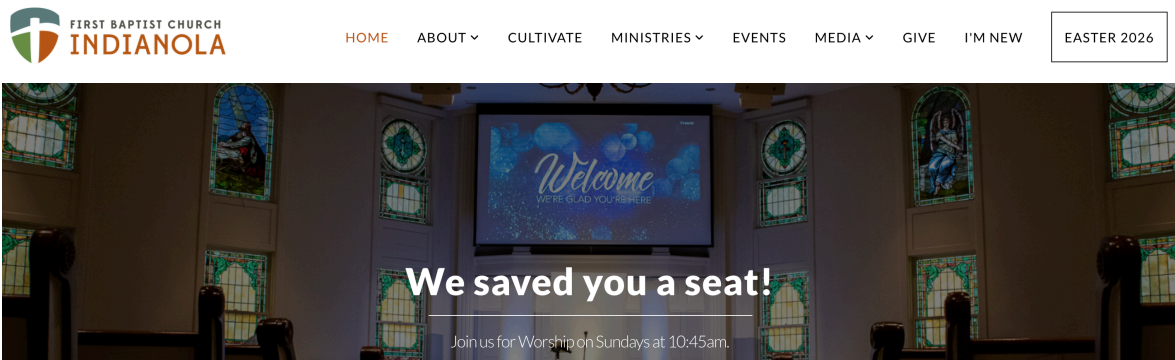

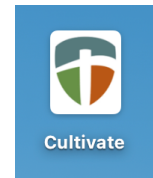
