Love for El Salvador



“...because He first loved us.”

Over the last few weeks, we have highlighted the work of our congregation in El Salvador. What began as a youth mission trip in 2008 is now a multi-faceted ministry which has been changing lives with the love of Jesus for 19 years. Last week, we profiled Elmer. Here are three more “success stories,” who like Elmer, we first encountered as a kid on one of our five student mission trips:

Sylvia has completed eight semesters of nursing school. She has three semesters left. Twice each day, she has to make the hour-long journey to the small city of Sonsonate for school. It’s hard work just to get to and from school each day but Sylvia is absolutely thriving. She always has a smile on her face. She has a servant’s heart and loves caring for patients.



Douglas, who through our support and encouragement finished high school, got a job in construction—at the very bottom of the manual labor chain. He wanted something better and started hanging out with the electricians. He asked us to



support him through trade school. We were happy to do it. He completed his electricians program but could only find part-time work. He saved his money, bought a car, and found full-time work that pays much better than he could find without the car.

Jose is married and has a cute son and daughter. He and his wife are active members of our sister congregation. Over many years, he has attended college while also working to support his family. A few weeks ago, he received a 4-year college degree in business. Jose also saved money to buy a small piece of land and to purchase the materials to build a home for his family. He and his cousin have provided the labor. They will be moving in by the end of this year.



More importantly, Sylvia, Douglas, and Jose love Jesus. We will see them again in eternity!

To continue our ministry, “Love for El Salvador,” through its 19th year, we need to raise \$4380. This will provide for 20 sponsorships for K-12 students, two trade school scholarships and allow us to refresh two classrooms at the Salvadoran Lutheran school.
