ACTS 16:23-30 (KJV)

- 23** And when they had laid many stripes upon them, they cast them into prison, charging the jailor to keep them safely:
- 24** Who, having received such a charge, thrust them into the inner prison, and made their feet fast in the stocks.
- 25** And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them.
- 26** And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed.
- 27** And the keeper of the prison awaking out of his sleep, and seeing the prison doors open, he drew out his sword, and would have killed himself, supposing that the prisoners had been fled.
- 28** But Paul cried with a loud voice, saying, Do thyself no harm: for we are all here.
- 29** Then he called for a light, and sprang in, and came trembling, and fell down before Paul and Silas,
- 30** And brought them out, and said, *Sirs, what must I do to be saved?*



MAIN THOUGHT

When life tries to break us, faith chooses to worship. True worship is not based on our circumstances—it is anchored in who God is. When our worship is louder than our wounds, God moves!

FAITH WORSHIPS BEFORE IT WINS



Acts 16:25 (KJV)

"And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them."

- **Reflection:** Faith does not wait for the breakthrough to worship. Worship is the weapon that releases Heaven's power.
- **Ask Yourself:**
 - Do I worship more when I see a miracle or when I need one?
 - Is my praise based on how I feel or on who God is?

II

FAITH REFUSES TO LET WOUNDS REWRITE IDENTITY



Reflection: Your pain is real, but it is not your identity. God defines you by His purpose, not your prison.

- **Ask Yourself:**
 - Have I allowed past wounds to shape how I see myself?
 - What truth from God's Word do I need to declare over my life?

III

FAITH CHANGES THE ATMOSPHERE



Acts 16:25-26 (KJV)

- 25** *"And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them."*
- 26** *"And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed."*

- **Reflection:** Worship has the power to shift environments because God's presence changes everything.
- **Ask Yourself:**
 - What atmosphere am I creating through my words and worship?
 - How can I choose praise before I see the breakthrough?
