Tuition assistance is limited and awarded based on eligibility and available funds. If tuition assistance is granted for the 2026–2027 school year, it is provided under the following terms and conditions:

- The student and family are expected to demonstrate alignment with the values and mission of Harvest Christian Academy and positively support Harvest Christian Academy and its staff.
- The student and family agree to support and abide by all HCA policies and guidelines, and the student must maintain satisfactory academic progress and appropriate conduct as outlined in the Student Handbook.
- Families certify that all financial information provided to HCA is true and complete to the best of their knowledge and that they will immediately notify the school if there is a significant change in financial circumstances that affects eligibility for tuition assistance.
- The amount of tuition assistance awarded is confidential between the family and the school and may not be discussed with other families or third parties.
- Tuition assistance is contingent upon the student remaining enrolled for the full 2026–2027 school year. If the student withdraws from HCA, the tuition assistance award will be prorated accordingly.
- The family is expected to make timely payments of any remaining tuition balances according to the school’s payment schedule and remain responsible for all other school-related expenses, including but not limited to lunch fees, athletic or extracurricular fees, and any additional charges incurred during the school year.

Failure to comply with these conditions may result in revocation of tuition assistance and/or termination of enrollment.

Tuition assistance is awarded at the discretion of Harvest Christian Academy and is not guaranteed from year to year. If awarded, tuition assistance will be credited directly to the family’s financial account and applied toward 2026–2027 tuition only. Tuition assistance is not transferable, is non-refundable, and must be reapplied for annually.

Harvest Christian Academy reserves the right to modify or revoke tuition assistance at any time based on available funding and school needs and/or terminate enrollment if the terms of this agreement are violated.

By signing this agreement, the parent or guardian agrees to communicate concerns directly with school administration in a respectful and constructive manner and refrain from making public or private statements that intentionally disparage or harm the reputation of the school, its officers, administrators, or staff.
