Trinity will once again have a food stand on July 3rd & 4th. Sign up sheets to help donate or run the stands will be shared this month.

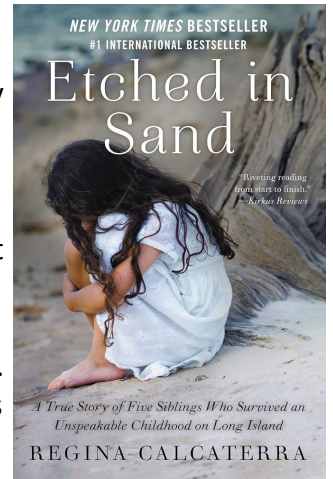


Ralston Archives
