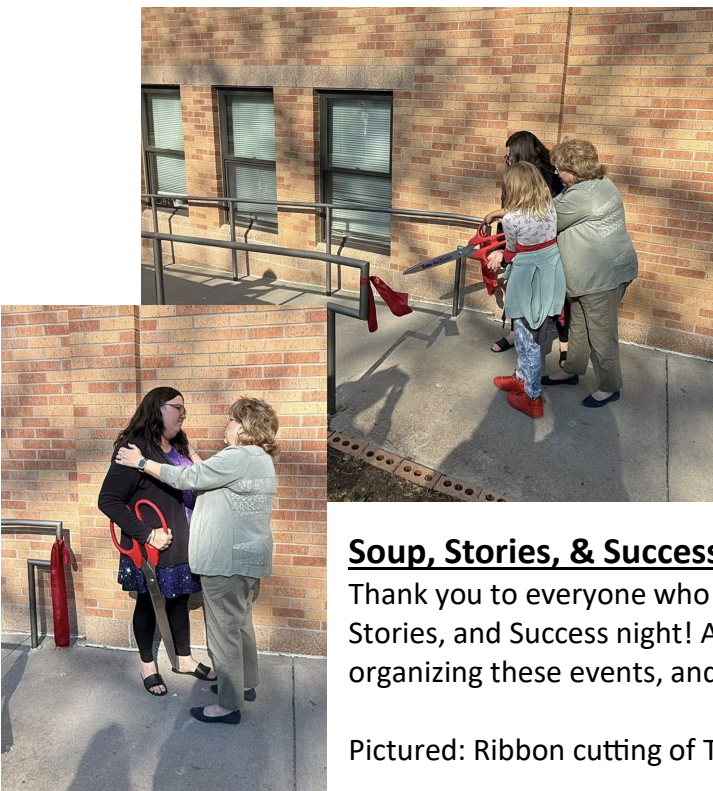
Thank you, Chris!

The Trinity Men meet the last Saturday of each month at 8am. They invite anyone interested to join them.

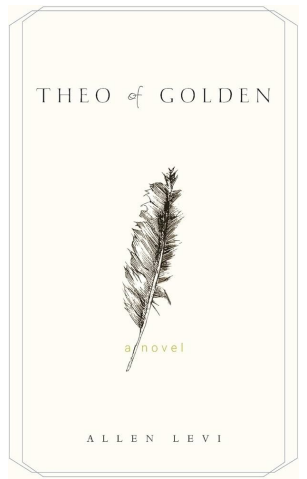

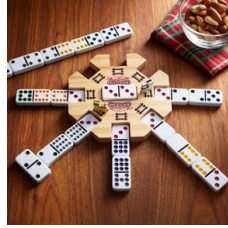
Esther Circle Outing
