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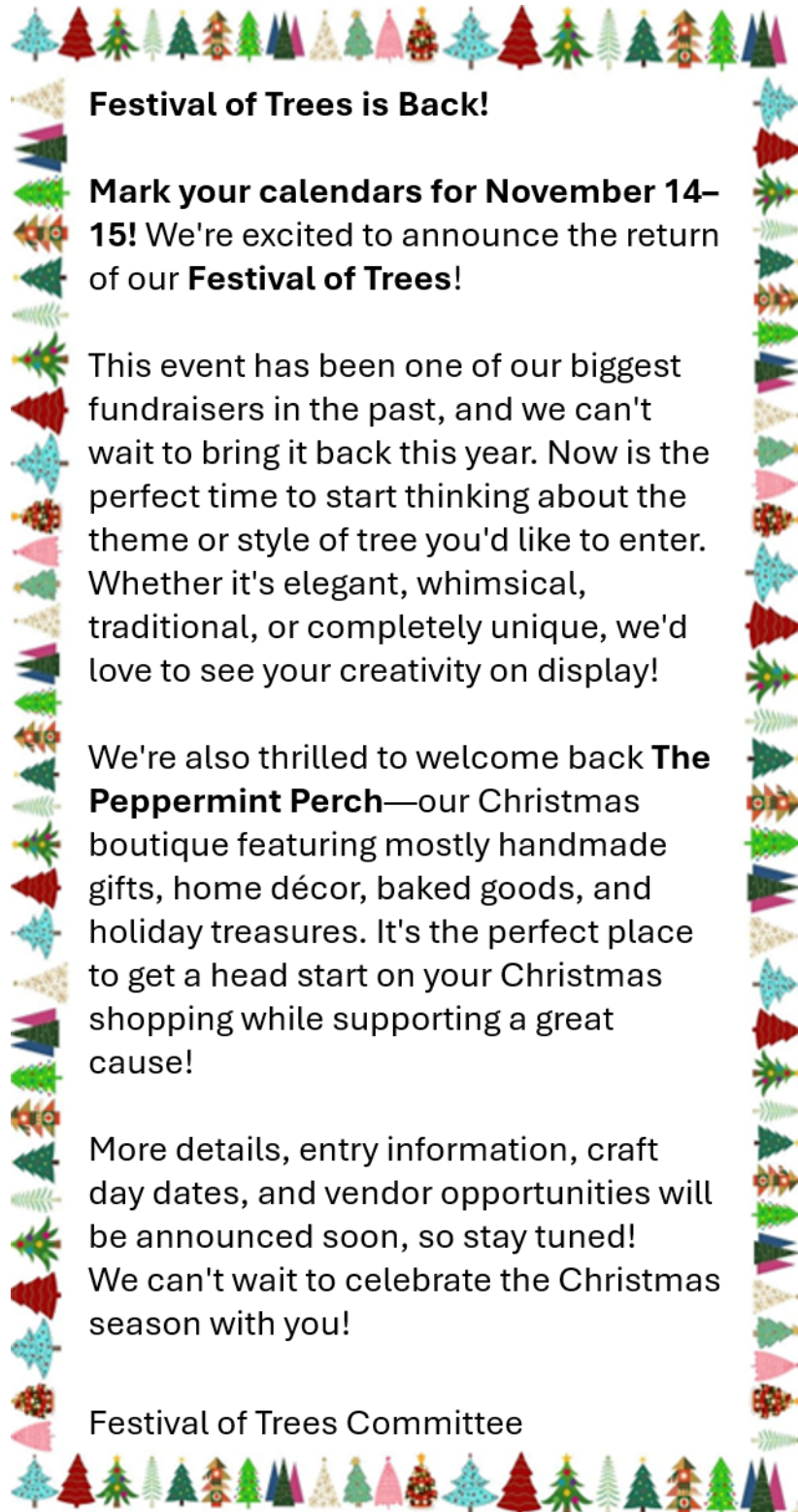


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Festival of Trees is Back!

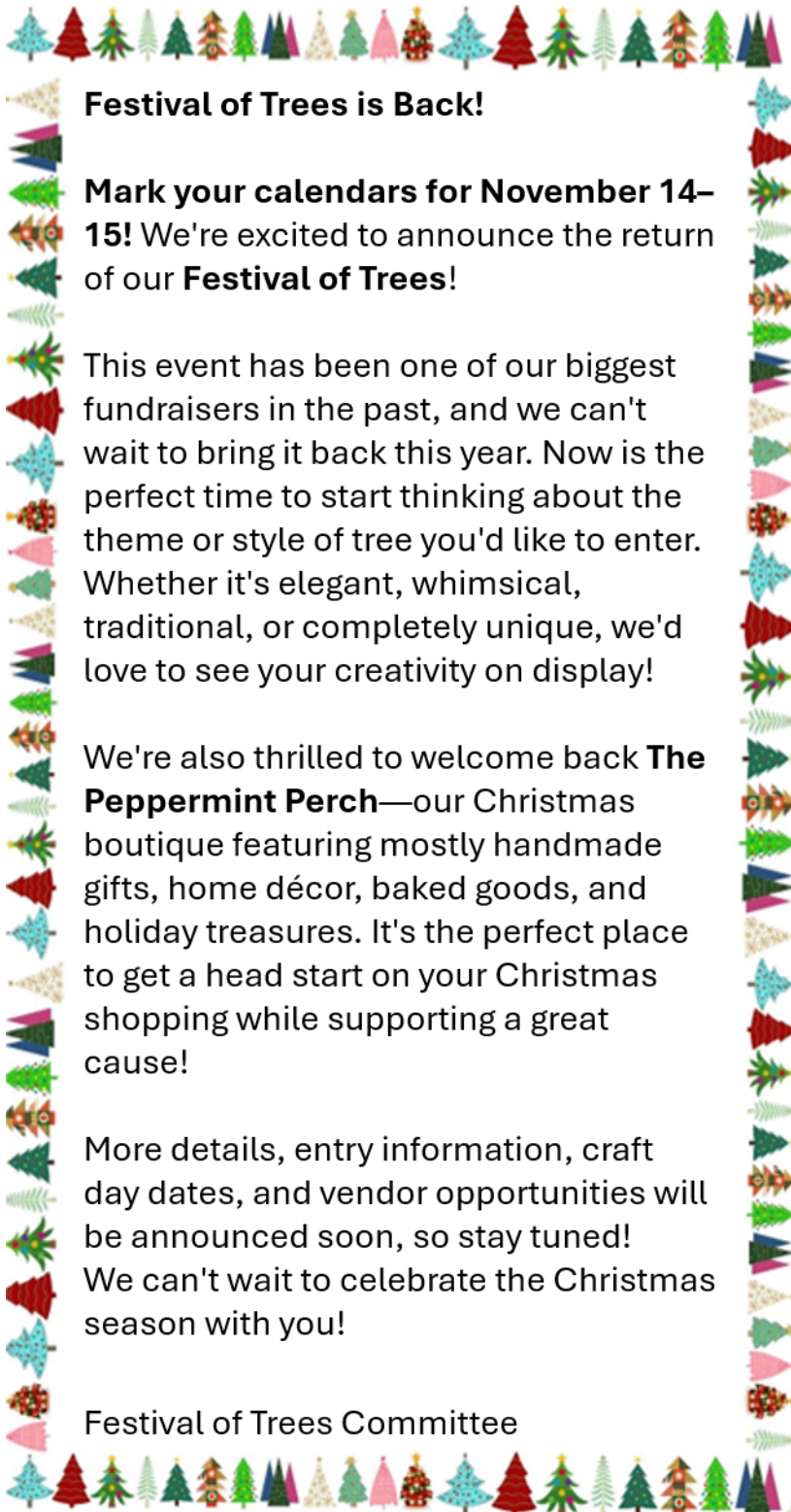
Mark your calendars for November 14–15! We're excited to announce the return of our **Festival of Trees!**

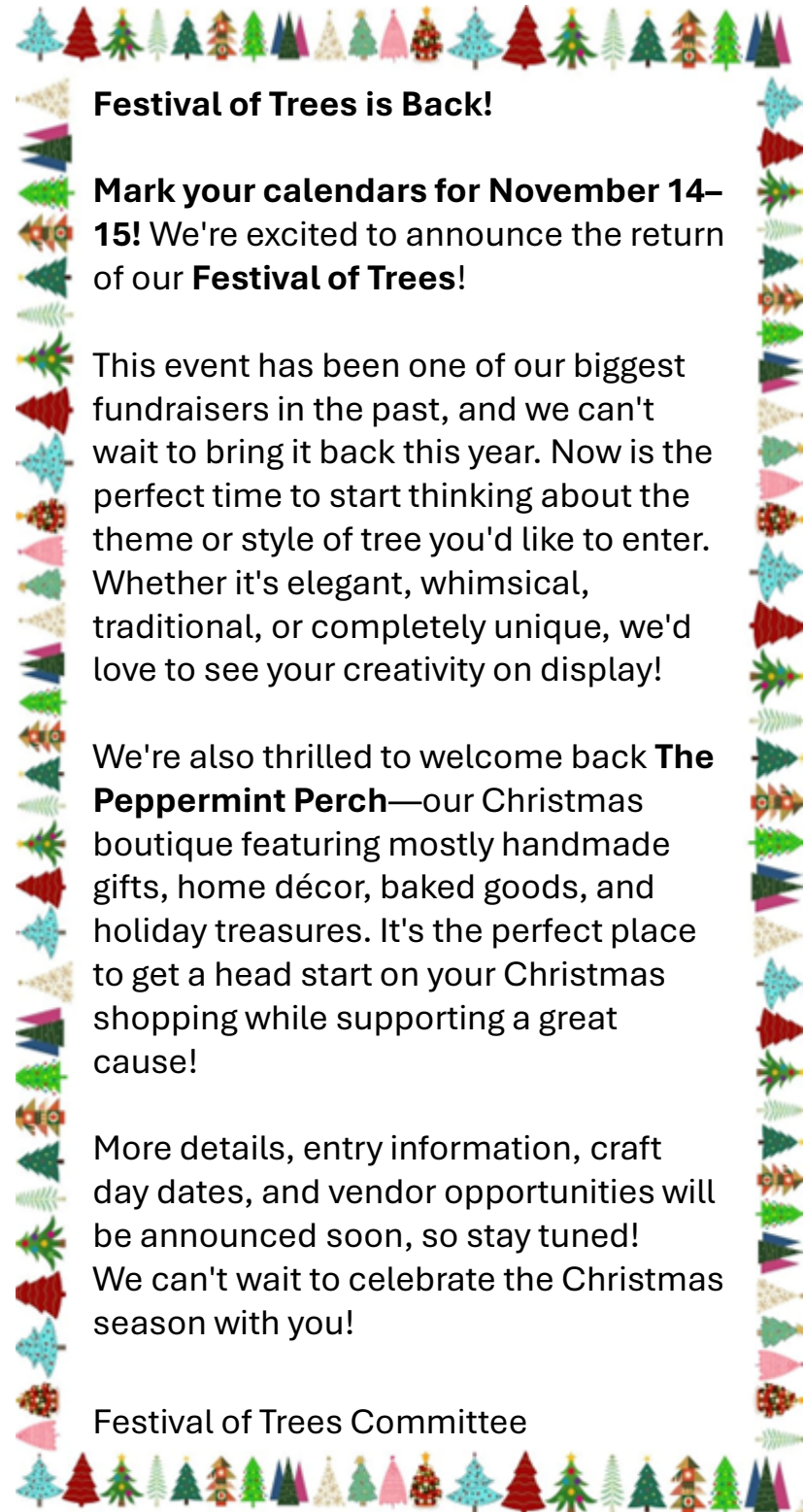
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
