Happy New Church Year MSBC!

The Church Staff just wrapped up our annual Church Staff Retreat. We were able to reflect on the past year of ministry and mission. We spent time evaluating the marks of a healthy church from Acts 2:42-47. If you recall, the marks of the early church were Lordship, Discipleship, Fellowship, and Partnership. The key word that made the difference between being an attender or a member, a spectator or a participator, spiritually weak or spiritually strong, spiritually frustrated or spiritually fruitful, spiritually indifferent or spiritually motivated, was devotion! The early believers were “continually devoting” themselves to the priorities of the church. They were determined, disciplined, and fully devoted to honor God and follow Jesus. There is no way any church can be healthy without its leadership and membership being devoted to these “marks” of ministry and mission. Therefore, we took a hard look at how we are doing in living out these priorities at MSBC. We asked all our Deacons and Church Council members to evaluate each area at MSBC. The result was positive, but we all realize there is much room for growth and improvement. We understand we have a God-centered, Jesus-focused, Spirit-filled and Bible driven plan and pattern for ministry. The 5-4-1 Pathway and Process of Discipleship is a great model we have developed over the years that is moving us in the right direction.

At this year’s Staff Retreat, we discerned we have a great vehicle in place to accomplish our mission. We simply just need to continue to develop it and increase its effectiveness. Therefore, on Sunday, September 13th, we will deliver in greater detail what that looks like for us in the 2026-2027 church year. I will explain what our Next Step is as a church to increase our health and effectiveness in the new church year. Perhaps you’re not even aware of some of the vehicles we have in place. I want to pull them out and put them on display and explain their function in the body of Christ. I want you to see what they look like and how they fit into our 5-4-1 Pathway and Process of Discipleship. In fact, the key to their effectiveness is church members being devoted to jumping in and taking them for a drive in Jesus’ name. Some of these vehicles are named the Welcome Team, Connect Team, Mentor Team, Go Team, and Operation B.L.E.S.S. mobile.

In addition, I will be introducing our new church year theme and focus which is “R3 Investments.” I’m looking forward to sharing all about this eternal investment plan that is guaranteed to pay huge dividends. This investment strategy is bible based and truly a game changer in making disciples who make disciples. The staff is excited to share our new theme and focus for the 2026/2027 church year. We are seeing God move at MSBC and we know we can increase our capacity to impact the lostness and push back the darkness in Cleveland County and beyond. We know we can experience greater breakthroughs, as one staff member shared, as we develop the Pathway and Process we already have in place.
