DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. If someone was looking at your life, would they see your faith shining?
2. What does it mean to “consider carefully how we listen” as mentioned in verse 18?
3. Why do you think Jesus uses the imagery of light to explain this to us?
4. How have you seen others shine their lamp instead of cover it?
5. When have you “uncovered your lamp” even when you didn’t want to? What came of doing that?

Heart- Level Reflection Questions

1. How do we light a lamp and then cover it up in regards to our faith?
2. What keeps you from not openly living out your faith sometimes?
3. How does verse 18 connect back to the parable of the soils?
4. Jesus says, “Whoever has will be given more; whoever does not have, even what they think they have will be taken from them.” What do you think He means by this?
5. What is God doing in your life right now that you need to do something about?

VERSE TO MEMORIZE

Luke 8:16

No one lights a lamp and hides it in a clay jar or puts it under a bed. Instead, they put it on a stand, so that those who come in can see the light.
