DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Week 40

1. What stands out to you most in Jesus' response in Luke 8:19–21?
2. What do you think Jesus means when He says His “mother and brothers are those who hear God’s word and put it into practice”?
3. Why is it significant that Jesus points to obedience rather than proximity as the mark of belonging to His family?
4. How does this passage connect back to the Parable of the Sower and Jesus’ warning to “consider carefully how you listen”?
5. What’s the difference between knowing God’s Word, agreeing with God’s Word, and actually putting God’s Word into practice?

Heart- Level Reflection Questions

1. Where can it be easiest for you to confuse being around Jesus—or around church—with actually following Jesus?
2. If someone watched your life for the next 30 days, where would they most clearly see God’s Word shaping the way you live? Where might it be harder to see?
3. When has God’s Word caused you to change your mind, priorities, behavior, or relationships? What makes obedience difficult when you already know what God’s Word says?
4. What is something you already know God is asking you to do that you haven’t put into practice yet? What would obedience look like this week?
