DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Week 41

1. The disciples faced a storm even though they were exactly where Jesus told them to be. What does this teach us about obedience and trusting God when life is difficult?
2. Have you ever felt like God was silent in the middle of something difficult? How did that affect your trust in Him?
3. Jesus asked the disciples, "Where is your faith?" What was He challenging them to believe about Him?
4. Jesus commanded the wind and waves, and they obeyed. What does this reveal about His authority?
5. Do you believe Jesus has ultimate authority over every part of life—our health, money, relationships, pain, and even death? Where is that hardest for you to believe?

Heart- Level Reflection Questions

1. What's the difference between trusting God to change our circumstances and trusting Him when He doesn't?
2. What "storm" in your life is currently making it difficult to focus on the power and authority of Jesus?
3. If you truly believe Jesus has authority over all things, what should change about the way you live this week?
