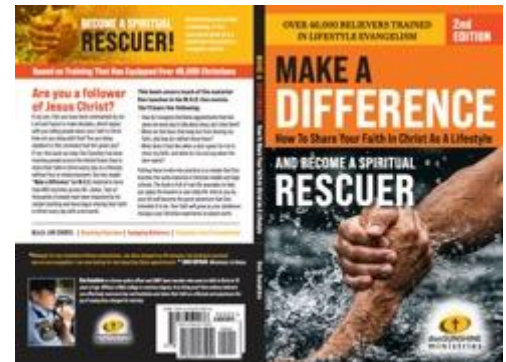
June 2026 Ministry Report
