The **Big Picture** of Revelation 12

► Genesis 3 → Christ → the cross → resurrection → Satan's defeat → persecution of God's people → final victory

> The central message of Revelation 12

► Satan has been decisively defeated by Christ, but in his remaining time he wages war against God's people; therefore Christians are called to endure faithfully, knowing that the Lamb has already won and Satan's time is short.

+ The connection to Genesis 3:15.

► In Genesis, God promises that the serpent will bruise the offspring of the woman, but the serpent's head will ultimately be crushed.

In Revelation 12, we see that conflict reaching its climax.
