Transportation Overview

The weeks are June 7th - 13th 14th - 21st We will have a couple trusted volunteers shuttle kids to and from camp. All drivers are above 21 with a clean driving record. Drivers contact info will be provided as we get closer to departure. (Parents let us know if you like to volunteer to drive

or just come hang out) With this format we are able to be inclusive to everyone's particular schedule, so if you can only come one week you can still be involved! This drive is about 8 and a half hours, depending on stops. The address is 19986 Hwy 65 Cedaredge, CO 81413.

Mission Details



Camp Cedaredge is a Christian Camp, and in the month of June they host multiple camps: 4 youth camps and 2 kids camps. As interns, we will be assisting with all the parts of running the camp. Jobs vary from kitchen duty, preparing meals for up to 400 attendees, running activities like **paintball** and **ropes course**, **maintenance** (filling water jugs, assisting with rec games, plumbing, building, mechanicing work, mowing, and yard work.) running the ice cream and coffee shop, snack shack, cleaning up and resetting for the next week.

Spiritual Growth

While these few weeks can be busy and fast paced, we are intentional about spending time with the Lord. We attend church every Sunday. We have gatherings to worship and will have devotions prepared to encourage us, and have a couple points to be thinking about and meditating on throughout the week as we are working. We will also be able to attend camp services with speaker Joseph Kellogg lead youth pastor @ Victory Church in Tulsa, OK and founder of Healthy Youth Ministry



Weekend Activities

Our fantastic camp coordinator, Glenn Jones, likes to make sure we have time off to have fun and rest.. We like to run some of the ropes course for everyone where they can enjoy them instead of running them. With supervision, We get a \$7 daily allowance in the snack shack and sweet shoppe. Everyone loves the trips we take to the top of the Mesa to fish in the streams and lakes, hike and canoe, and just hang out in nature or taking the camp boat out for some tubing on the local lake. We have an annual trip to Roosters, a wing restaurant in Grand Junction. Our Ouray trip is one of our favorite adventures and it's normally a full day of exploring. This year we are looking at taking a group down the Ouray downstream ferrata which will be an awesome new adventure for everyone! More info to come on this one!





Sleeping Arrangements

Girls will have some classrooms and loft above the kitchen with mattresses in them. Boys will be in a bunkhouse on the other side of camp. Be sure to bring some bedding or a sleeping bag! Both will have access to showers and bathrooms and washers and dryers available. Curfew unless working is in bed by 12:00pm

Prices

We are still working on final prices but thankfully with us not having to pay for a place to stay or food during the week this gives us lots of wiggle room to keep the trip cost effective Here's kind the estimated total as of now which we can edit and play with as needed - **Trip Cost:** The cost of the Camp Cedar Edge Mission Trip **\$200 for one week** or **\$255 for two weeks**. This cost includes round-trip transportation from Cottonwood, AZ, all weekday meals provided at camp, weekend meals (including a celebration dinner), planned group activities, and a special day trip to Ouray during the first week featuring Via Ferrata gear rental, Box Falls, and a hot springs visit. Students staying for a second week will participate in lower-cost group activities, such as a camp-led boat trip, along with additional weekend food and activities. Travel meals to, and from Colorado, and personal spending money and snacks are not included
