

Hebrews 10:19-25 Hold Fast to Hope

Hebrews has spent ten chapters laying a foundation.

The Christian life does not begin with what we do for God, but with what Christ has done for us.

"Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus" Hebrews 10:19 (NKJV)

But now, because of Jesus, believers have boldness to enter the Holiest.

The throne of God has become, a throne of grace.

For we are the circumcision, who worship God in the Spirit, rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh, (Philippians 3:3 NKJV)

Your confidence before God is not grounded in your record for Christ, but in Christ's record for you.

"And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death. (Revelation 12:11 NKJV)

The blood of Jesus is the foundation we stand on every day of our Christian life.

by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, (Hebrews 10:20 NKJV)

The way into God's presence was opened when the body of Jesus was broken for sinners. and [having] a High Priest over the house of God, (Hebrews 10:21 NKJV)

First, we have the blood of Jesus. Second, we have the priestly ministry of Jesus.

Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them. (Hebrews 7:25 NKJV)

The same Jesus who died for you now lives to represent you.

let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. (Hebrews 10:22 NKJV)

Now comes the first of three great exhortations in this passage: ***let us draw near.***

That's the heartbeat of salvation—Not merely escape from judgment, but nearness to God.

These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life, and that you may [continue to] believe in the name of the Son of God. (1 John 5:13 NKJV)

God does not intend His children to live in perpetual uncertainty.

how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? (Hebrews 9:14 NKJV)

In Christ, there is inward and outward consecration to God.

...He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, (Titus 3:5b NKJV)

Because Christ has cleansed you, you do not have to live at a distance from God.

Let us hold fast the confession of [our] hope without wavering, for He who promised [is] faithful. (Hebrews 10:23 NKJV)

Here is the second exhortation: **let us hold fast.**

Our hope holds because the God who made the promise cannot fail.

And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as [is] the manner of some, but exhorting [one another], and so much the more as you see the Day approaching. (Hebrews 10:24-25 NKJV)

Now we come to the third exhortation: **let us consider one another.**

Biblical community does not merely comfort believers; it calls them forward into love and obedience.

And the eye cannot say to the hand, "I have no need of you"; nor again the head to the feet, "I have no need of you." (1 Corinthians 12:21 NKJV)

The closer we get to Christ's return, the more urgently we need worship, fellowship, and encouragement.

Draw near... Hold fast... Consider one another.

And do it all in the confidence that He who promised is faithful.
