**The life that pleases God has always been, and will always be, a life of faith.**

*For by it the elders obtained a [good] testimony. By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible. (Hebrews 11:2-3 NKJV)*

Scripture is clear... no one has ever been justified by works.

*"knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law but by faith in Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, that we might be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law; for by the works of the law no flesh shall be justified. (Galatians 2:16 NKJV)*

We know creation because God has spoken.

*In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. (Genesis 1:1 NKJV)*

*By the word of the LORD the heavens were made, And all the host of them by the breath of His mouth. (Psalm 33:6 NKJV)*

**Faith begins where God has spoken, a life that pleases Him is built there.**

*By faith Abel offered to God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, through which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts; and through it he being dead still speaks. (Hebrews 11:4 NKJV)*

Outward religion without inward trust cannot please God.

*He answered and said to them, "Well did Isaiah prophesy of you hypocrites, as it is written: 'This people honors Me with [their] lips, But their heart is far from Me. (Mark 7:6 NKJV)*

**Do we come before God leaning on Christ, or are we still bringing ourselves?**

*By faith Enoch was taken away so that he did not see death, "and was not found, because God had taken him"; for before he was taken he had this testimony, that he pleased God. But without faith [it is] impossible to please [Him], for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and [that] He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him. (Hebrews 11:5-6 NKJV)*

Faith is not an accessory; it's essential to every truly God-pleasing act.

*But he who doubts is condemned if he eats, because [he does] not [eat] from faith; for whatever [is] not from faith is sin. (Romans 14:23 NKJV)*

So faith is not a decorative quality added to religion. It is the pulse of spiritual life.

*And you will seek Me and find [Me], when you search for Me with all your heart. (Jeremiah 29:13 NKJV)*

**The Christian life is sustained not by empty motion, but by living trust.**

*"By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith. (Hebrews 11:7 NKJV)*

**Faith does not wait for visible proof before obeying.**

*[There is] therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. (Romans 8:1 NKJV)*

Once again Hebrews insists that righteousness comes by faith.

*for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, (Romans 3:23 NKJV)*

*For the wages of sin [is] death, but the gift of God [is] eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 6:23 NKJV)*
