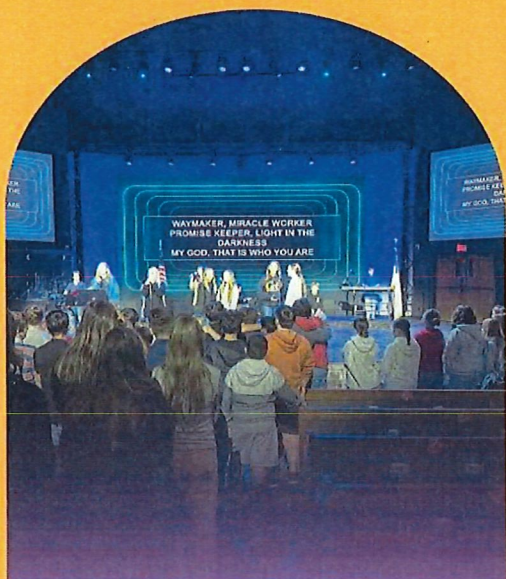


Pacific Christian Middle School Newsletter

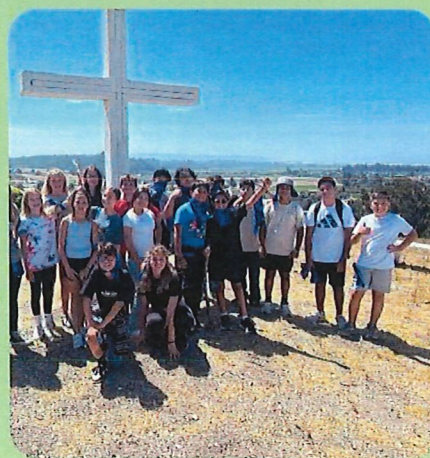
Community Service Hours, PE Uniforms, Student Materials
