CAMP INFORMATION

SLSC has an excellent health and safety record enhanced by:

- Nutritious meals at the camp dining hall
 - Certified lifeguards for waterfront activities
 - Cabin leaders provide oversight and support
 - Health services available 24/7
 - A local hospital within 5 miles for emergencies
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Campers are invited to begin or renew their faith, walk with Christ, and grow in that relationship through cabin small groups, worship services, prayer and guest speakers. Programming is designed by a team of youth and children's pastors dedicated to providing kids with a week of fun and personal growth!

A cabin leader is assigned to every room.

He/she becomes involved with students through daily discussion and prayer times, and provides support as campers make new friends and become involved in camp activities. Cabin leaders and all camp staff complete an application process and have a criminal background check on file.

Free time activities include:

Jetski tubing, bonfires, basketball, volleyball, minigolf, slip n slide, waterfront inflatables, paddleboats, swimming, canoeing, ga'gaball, speedball, disc golf, a game room, and more!

CAMP RULES

Lack of cooperation, unnecessary roughness, lack of respect for property or unwholesome attitude will result in expulsion from camp. Parents bear responsibility and expense to transport the camper home.

1. Show consideration for others
2. Attendance at classes, chapel, and evening services is required
3. Room and grounds must be kept clean. Churches and campers will pay for damages
4. Cover-up, shirt, or large towel will be worn to and from the beach and after swimming
5. Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times while on campus (to/from beach included)
6. Campers must be in bed and quiet by "lights out"
7. Clothing must be modest (see "dress policy")
8. Campers may not enter another cabin without cabin leader's permission

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DRESS POLICY

All campers are expected to dress modestly

- All attire and bathing suits are to be modest
 - Shoes and shirts are required to be worn in the dining hall and at all services
 - No spaghetti straps or plunging necklines
 - No hats or shirts with inappropriate imprints (i.e. alcohol/tobacco)
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LOST & FOUND

SLSC is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. It is the camper's responsibility to check in the office for lost items. We strongly discourage bringing sentimental objects or items of value, electronic devices, sports equipment, etc.

Shipping will be charged for returned items.

Lost and found is kept for one month after week of camp.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Absolutely no fireworks, firearms, tobacco, weapons, alcohol, illegal drugs, pets, hair color spray, skateboards, roller skates/blades, grills, silly string or body paint.



MEDICATIONS

Update online health and medication details before arrival if necessary or send a printed list of changes with parent signature and date. Upon arrival bring all meds to the nurse in a plastic zip bag and in original container/label including:

camper name, doctor name, prescription number, date prescribed, medication name, and dosing.

****No weekly/daily pill containers will be accepted. It is the camper's responsibility to go to the nurse for meds. Do not send over the counter meds with camper.****
