Volunteer Descriptions

Purpose: Allow those who consider Sonrise their home church community to engage in service regardless of skill level.

Qualifications:

- Agree with Sonrise’s Core Values and Core Beliefs. (<https://www.sonrisebc.org/what-we-believe>)
- Adheres to the Sonrise Volunteer Values (listed below).
- Consider Sonrise their home church community. (Membership may be required for some positions.)
- Supportive of church leadership.
- Committed to peaceful conflict management (Matt 18:15-35).
- Is a punctual and joyful servant who cares for others.

Sonrise Volunteer Values:

- Valuing those Christ died for.
- Living in community.
- Being generous with time, talent, and treasure.
- Growing in the practice and understanding of your faith.

Volunteer Opportunities: Listed below are some opportunities for volunteering at Sonrise. Please check all opportunities you are interested in and turn this form into the church office at your earliest convenience. Most opportunities require no experience and are designed as an entry point for service. As you mature in Christ and desire more opportunities, ask about our ministry leadership positions.

HOSPITALITY TEAM:		
Coffee	On Sunday mornings make coffee and set out coffee and hot water pots in the lobby. Ensure the coffee bar is clean, orderly and stocked. Assist people as needed. After service, remove coffee and hot water pots from coffee bar, clean and put away.	
Greeters	Greeters welcome everyone coming into the foyer. They are there to create a loving, welcoming first impression to everyone's Sunday morning. Answer questions, direct people to where they need to go, assist with coffee, and hand out bulletins. Keep foyer tidy as people enter. Welcome new guests with a welcome gift.	
Ushers	Ushers help everyone get to their seats. They make sure there are enough chairs. Tidy up the sanctuary throughout the morning as needed. Take care of communion. Take care of any distractions during service. Take a head count when sermon starts. Do security checks in and outside of the building during service. Before service, hang signs out front near sidewalk. After service take down signs and properly store them.	

WORSHIP TEAM:		
Worship Team Musician	Practice and perform for Sunday worship team. Opportunities may include any musical instrument and vocals.	
Worship Apprentice	Train alongside the worship team in hopes of being a future worship team member.	
Sound Production	Has a working knowledge and desire to participate in sound on Sunday mornings as well as worship practice.	
Video Production	Has a working knowledge and desire to participate in video production on Sunday mornings as well as special tasks as requested.	
Proclaim Slides	Willing to serve the Lord by helping congregants engage in worship, free from distraction by making visual cues for worship seamless and non-distracting on Sunday mornings.	

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY TEAM: (Background check and church membership required.)		
Sunday Morning Helper	Assist the teacher either in nursery, pre-school, or children's church. Helping the teacher maintain a safe and focused environment. Depending on the age group you are in, you will also be playing with the children or helping with crafts/games, etc.	

LIFE GROUP TEAM:		
Life Group Host	Open home for a life group to meet. Prepare a light snack and create a welcoming environment for people to live, love, and learn together.	

FACILITIES TEAM:		
Building Maintenance	Help maintain the Sonrise building by fixing sinks, toilets, electrical (if qualified), paint, carpeting, and other minor repairs.	
Grounds Crew	Help maintain the Sonrise church grounds, by mowing, edging, fertilizing, weeding, planting flowers, trimming trees, snow removal, etc.	
Cleaning	The Cleaning Coordinator will develop a schedule and checklist for weekly cleaning of the church. Cleaners will be responsible for executing the schedule and cleaning tasks given to them by the Cleaning Coordinator.	

Next Steps:

1. Check all opportunities where you are interested in serving.
2. A Director or Coordinator will contact you to discuss your interests.
3. You will go through a brief orientation for the ministry in which you will serve.
4. Continue to be a great support to our church family and ask questions of your ministry Director/Coordinator as needed.
