

2026 BIBLE READING PLAN

— A HELPFUL GUIDE WHEN READING THE BIBLE —

SCRIPTURE

Open your Bible to the assigned reading for the day and read it. It's that simple.

OBSERVATION

Write down what is happening, what is being taught and who is doing the teaching. You may write something along the lines of, "In this passage Jesus is speaking to a large crowd of people about attitude. He is going through a list of attitudes or approaches to life and its circumstances that God blesses." It can be as short or long as you'd like to make it.

APPLICATION

Reflect on your own life for a moment. How does this scripture apply to your life? As you read it, is there something that sticks out to you specifically about what is being taught or happening that connects with an area in your life which might need

some refining? You could write something down like, "When Jesus said 'Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness...' it made me think of how, when I am hungry, I will stop at nothing to satisfy my hunger. I want to pursue Jesus that way. I want to want Jesus the way I want a cold drink of water on a hot day or a good meal after skipping lunch. I want to hunger and thirst for righteousness."

PRAYER

Prayer is simply communicating with God. It's our opportunity to tell Him what's on our hearts and minds and is especially powerful when we couple it with the truth of God's Word.

Don't pressure yourself. Prayer isn't about perfection; it's about being present and aware that Jesus gave His life to give you this moment. So embrace it.
