

Different Offerings Tunnel Relay

Materials

- Black and white hearts (next page)
- One of each Cain and Abel offering illustrations (following pages)
- Large sheet to make a tunnel between tables or rows of chairs
- Tape

Instructions

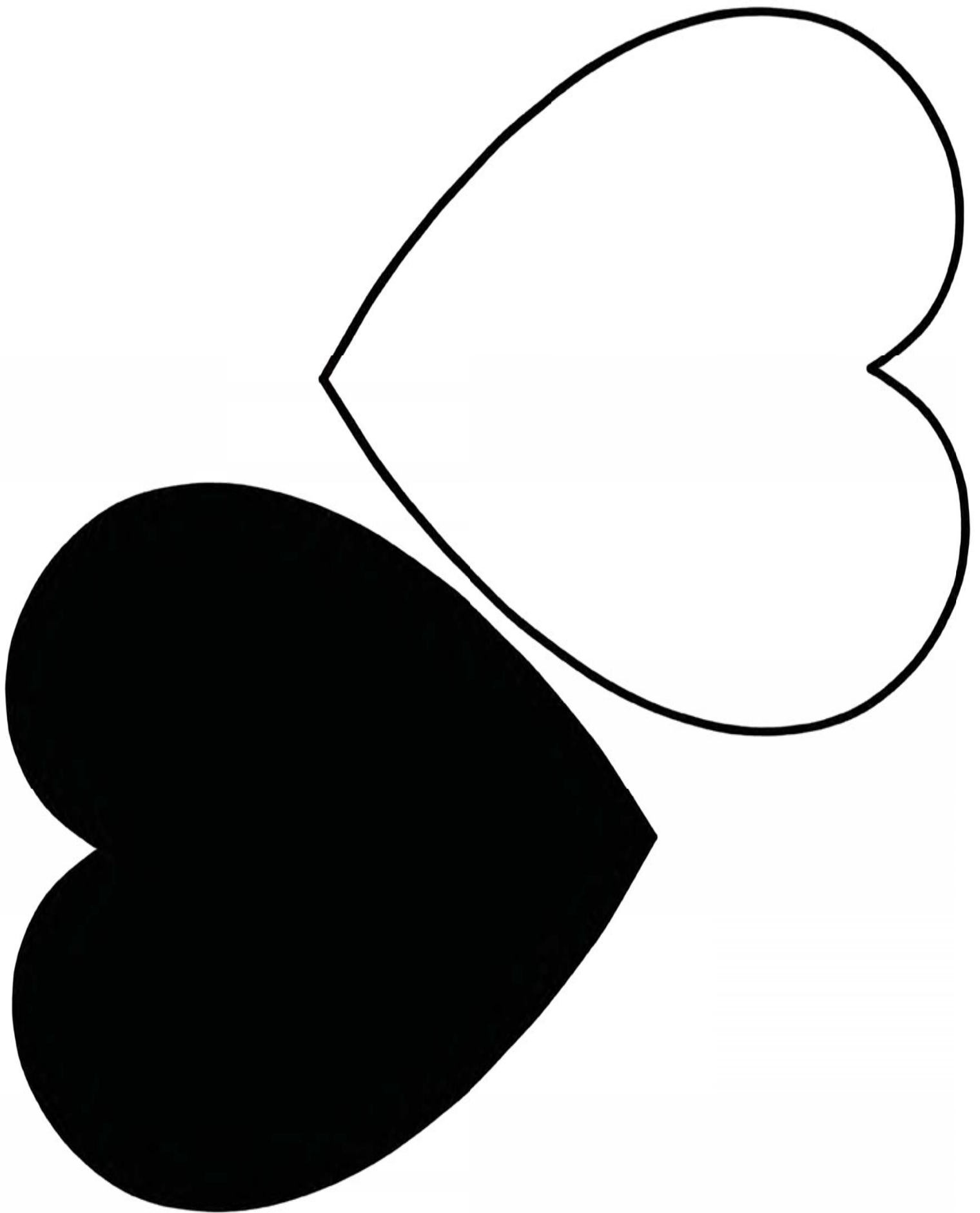
Print and cut out 1–2 white and black hearts per student and place them in an open container. Set up two rows of chairs or tables to make a “relay tunnel” using the large sheet. Place the heart container next to the tunnel entrance. Tape the Cain and Abel illustrations to the seat backs of two chairs facing the tunnel exit.

When you say go, children will take turns grabbing a heart from the container, running or crawling through the tunnel, and placing the black hearts on the chair with the Cain picture and the white hearts on the chair with the Abel picture. Continue until all students have gone through the tunnel once or twice.

You may want to just do the relay without the tunnel and time them to make it more challenging. Repeat as time allows.

Suggested discussion

God is omniscient. He knows everything—even what we are thinking! We can’t trick him by acting good on the outside and thinking bad things on the inside. He knows it all! God knew Cain hated him and did not make his offering out of love. God also knew Abel’s heart and knew that Abel gave his offering to God because Abel loved him and wanted to obey him.



Print and cut out 1-2 hearts per student.
