Abram and Lot Puppets

Materials

- ☐ Abram and Lot Puppets (next page)
- ☐ Scissors
- ☐ Crayons
- ☐ Craft sticks
- ☐ Glue or tape

Instructions

Note: you may want to make a set of puppets for yourself to use during the Suggested Discussion.

Print and cut out one Abram and one Lot puppet for each student (or have students do the cutting). Have students color each puppet then glue or tape a craft stick to the back. Fold one side back over the craft stick and glue or tape together.

Suggested Discussion

Have students use their puppets during the discussion. Everyone, hold up your Abram puppet. God showed Abram the land he wanted him to live in.

- ?** Now show me your other puppet, Abram's nephew. What is his name? *Lot.*

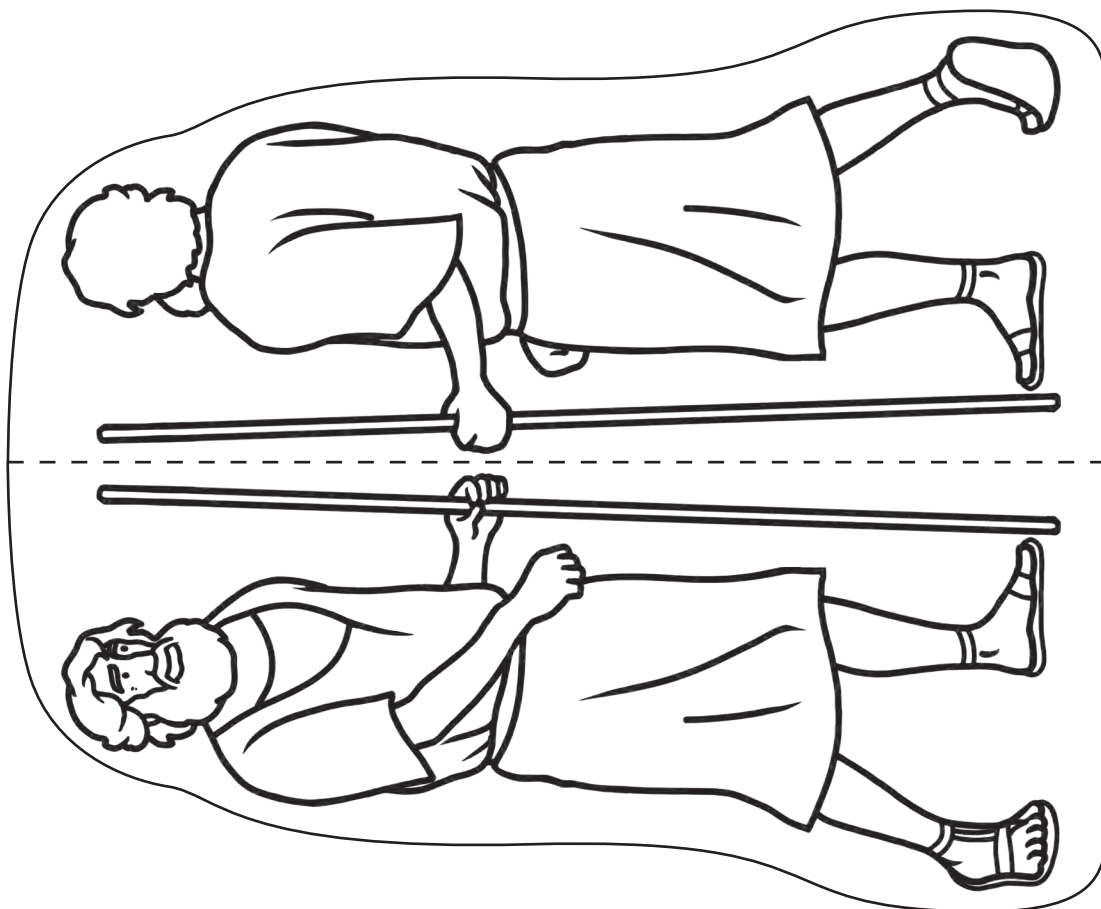
Right. Abram was Lot's uncle. Hold up your Abram and Lot puppets together. Lot came with Abram to the land of Canaan. But they both had so many sheep and goats and servants, they just couldn't all live in the same place together.

- ?** So what did Abram say they should do? *Separate. Go two different ways.*

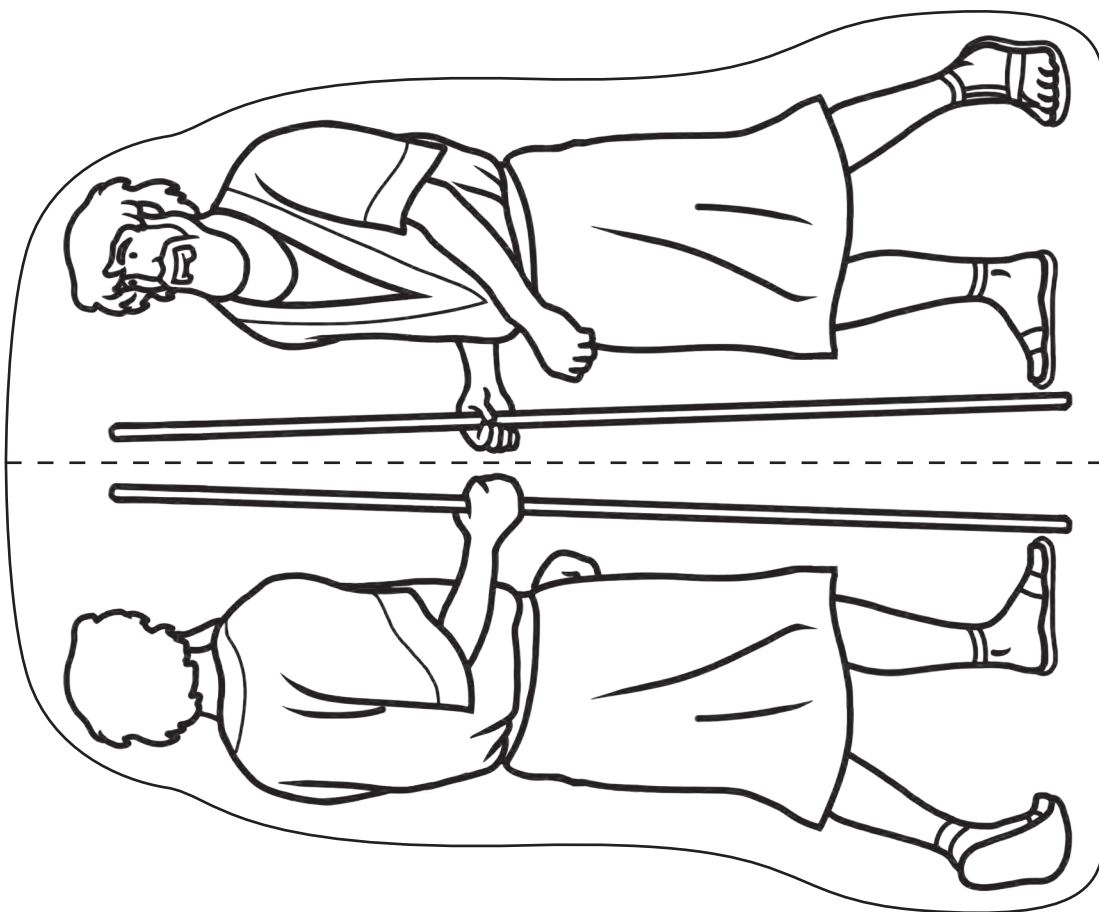
Lot chose some very nice-looking land. But it led him to a wicked place. Make your Lot puppet go one way.
