"Rabbi," Nathanael replied, "You are the Son of God!"

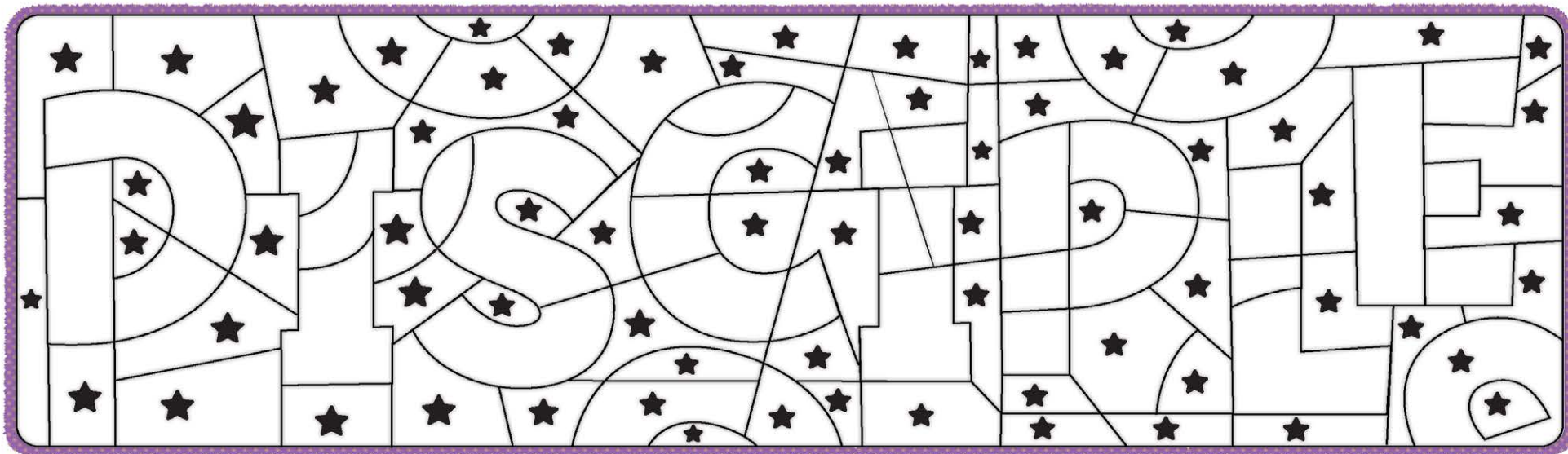
Jesus responded, "You believe because I told you I saw you under the fig tree? You will see much greater things than this."
