Dear Saint Andrew's Parishioners and Friends,

What is your biggest concern? What preoccupies your mind? If you were truly free for a couple days, what would you do? Your answers reveal your religion. *Religion* comes from a word meaning monastic vows or the acts that one does because of their beliefs. It is thought to come from a root meaning "bound." Religion is the bond that drives our daily life.

We identify our religion as Christian and gather each day (especially Sunday) to "worship." That word comes from an early term meaning "worthy" and was applied to God and people held in high regard and deserving of our respect and attention.

Our daily practices are 'worship' in a real sense. There are things we need to do to survive, but there is plenty of time for other pursuits as well. If things like prayer or reading Scripture (or other spiritual material) are not on your mind, or schedule, then it is fair to question what are you really worshipping? If it isn't the Lord—then pretty clearly it is someone or something unworthy of our worship. You become what you worship, literally, so we need to make sure we are focusing on God.

Religion is primarily a relationship. Relationships are organic. They are in a constant state of flux—moving toward greater health or dissipation. God has set us free to choose Him or another. We can claim that He is our center without actually making Him the center of our real lives.

Our purpose as a parish is to support your growth in love and trust with The Triune God at the center of our shared lives. We hope you will be more faithful in attendance and participation. Jesus formed the church and He wants us to be church. Let's do this together!
