CONVENTION DELEGATES ARE STILL NEEDED: The annual Diocesan Convention is Friday-Saturday, **Nov 20–21**, at St. Luke’s in Jackson, TN. BENEDICTINE SPIRITUALITY

WRITTEN TEXTS AND TRADITION: The Biblical text must be read and interpreted. Even a simple command (Thou shalt not kill) must be analyzed in the original language (the Hebrew says “not murder”). The Jewish Bible in Hebrew must be read in the Greek as well to determine what the ancients thought—ironically, we have Septuagint texts older than the Hebrew.
