Dear Saint Andrew's Friends and Parishioners,

In some ways June is a restart as summer gives us vacation breaks and no school. New starts and new adventures are vital.

Recently in Morning Prayer we read Joshua 1. I hope you are familiar with his story. He was Moses' lieutenant and successor. The Torah ends with Moses' departure and the Hebrew slaves about to enter the land God promised to give them.

The Lord gives Joshua instructions, repeating three times that they must be "strong and very courageous." Such advice is relevant for us as well. It is easy to be "weak, discouraged, and afraid" when things seem so out of control. Even when physically weak, our soul can be strong in faith. We are in difficult days and we need a brave heart.

The Israelites are instructed to obey the Law so that "it goes well for you in the land." Growing up, I always misunderstood the Law as the effort to be good so we can go to heaven, while it actually is the response of saved people in covenant with God. The Torah's primary purpose is to guide our relationships so that life on earth will be abundant. While Gentiles enter this covenant (by grace) through Christ, the New Testament has its own set of expectations—and one can argue that most social ills are a reflection of life lived in contradiction to God's Instruction.

Finally, the Lord tells Israel to "meditate" on the Law. The word has several meanings, but it literally means mumbling and implies talking to yourself as you read (because in the ancient cultures you read out loud) and trying to understand how to internalize and live out the commands.

I recommend taking the instruction of Joshua 1 to heart—individually and corporately. We, too, are in the process of securing our land and submitting to the Kingdom Rule of Jesus (in Hebrew it is Joshua). Our greatest foe is our own sin and struggle with "the satan." Our culture is hostile. It won't be easy—so be very brave and very strong.
