HAITI REPRESENTATIVE AT SAINT ANDREW'S: West Tennessee Haiti Partnership, a diocesan ministry that supports St. Vincent's Center for Handicapped Children in Port-au-Prince, is hosting trauma surgeon Dr. Pierre-Marie Woolley in West Tennessee this weekend. Dr. Woolley is a trauma and orthopedic surgeon who serves in the only fully functioning hospital in the Haitian capital. He was Medical Director of St. Vincent's for years and is a long-standing member of the Board of Directors. He has helped countless children with disabilities and deformities, offering skilled and compassionate care even amid periods of social instability, mass-casualty events, and ongoing humanitarian crisis. On Apr 12 at 11:30 AM, we're having an informal lunch and discussion with Dr. Woolley in the parish hall. Everyone is welcome to attend; lunch has been ordered for those who signed up ahead of time.

Jude and 2 Peter share the same material, but who borrowed from whom? 1 Peter says Paul is hard to understand. The Synoptic Gospels seem connected. This is even more apparent in the Jewish Bible.
