Packing List (enough for 5 days)

Clothing

- Shirts
- Pants (Leggings must be worn with oversized shirts)
- Shorts (**Spandex volleyball shorts are not acceptable attire**)
- Theme-day outfits
 - Tuesday- Disney Day (Pack Neon for a surprise Night Activity)
 - Wednesday- Country vs. Country Club
 - Thursday- Luau
- Modest Sleepwear
- Underwear and socks
- Light jacket for services
- Close toeshoes
 - Sandals and other shoes are acceptable but it is strongly encouraged to have a pair of closed toeshoes
- Swimwear (Reminder: Shirts must be worn at all times outside of the water.)
 - Ladies
