# Ray's Reflections

#### **Casas por Cristo Trip Information**

We will have another meeting on January 8<sup>th</sup> at Noon to make further plans for our mission trip to Juarez March 12-17, 2023. We will need firm commitments from those planning to go because we will have to make another payment to Casas soon after that.

The cost for the meal plan, motel and gas will be \$200.00 per person. Some extra money will be needed for meals while traveling, other spending, and an offering for the Casas missionary leading the trip. Older children through teens can go, but we are requesting a parent or guardian go with them. While Kevin plans to go, he cannot supervise a whole group of teens by himself.

Please talk with Ray or Kevin if you have questions or to get your name on the list of those planning to go. We will plan to take up to 20 individuals on the trip.

#### **Kairos Report**

Six individuals went to the Dalhart Correctional Facility and ministered to 42 inmates, a group of inmate volunteers, and a few prison staff. While the guys were inside ministering, there was a large group of ladies and some men who worked really hard preparing meals and other gifts to be delivered each day. The inmates were blown away by the love and acceptance shown to them. While not everything went according to plan, many were touched by the love and the gospel as it was proclaimed. Several decisions for Christ were made. It was a great and exhausting weekend, but well worth the effort. Thank you all for your prayers and support of this ministry.

Jesus Eve? What's with that? Just an attempt to really place emphasis on the reason for the season of great joy-Jesus, that's all. A free-will offering will be taken to be given to a local and foreign mission ministry at the end of each service.

**Sermon Series -** In January we will start a four week sermon series on the life of Daniel and his three friends. These men were incredibly used by God to transform Israel and the ungodly nation that they lived in.

The four men's stories can be of great encouragement to each of us living in troubled ungodly times today. We need to know the anchor that we have in God's word and Holy Spirit, and make ourselves available to God no matter the cost to ourselves.

Gifts For The King - As usual over the Christmas season, we will take a special offering for two missions that we support. These are the Sparrow House Ministry and the spring Juarez Mission trip. The money given between now and the end of January will be split evenly unless you designate your gift for one specific mission. Our goal is to raise over \$15,000!

The Juarez mission will take \$10,000 to pay for all of the materials for the mission to build a home. The rest of the expenses such as fuel costs, food, etc, are provided by those who go on the trip.

**Manhattan Christian College** - On the weekend of the 4<sup>th</sup> of December, a team from Manhattan Christian College will be here. They will be providing a time for junior and senior highers and adults to hear about MCC as an educational destination for at least one year after they graduate from high school. An update about MCC will be provided at the Sunday school hour in the fellowship hall for all adults and junior and senior highers.

On Sunday morning, a staff member from MCC will provide the sermon for both services. We will take up a special offering for MCC at each service.
